CORONAVIRUS PREVENTATIVE MEASURES



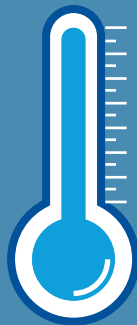
GUESTS AND CREW WHO HAVE TRAVELED FROM, VISITED OR TRANSITED VIA AIRPORTS IN China, Hong Kong, Macau, South Korea, Iran, or any municipality in Italy subject to lockdown (quarantine) measures by the Italian Government within 14 days of their voyage embarkation, regardless of nationality, will not be allowed to board any of our vessels. Travel companions of these guests who share the same stateroom will also be denied boarding.



Guests or crew who have reported on the Pre-Embarkation Public Health Questionnaire or who **APPEAR SYMPTOMATIC, ARE FEELING UNWELL, ARE EXHIBITING FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS OR EXHIBIT DIFFICULTY BREATHING** WILL BE DENIED BOARDING.

NON-TOUCH TEMPERATURE SCREENINGS

for all guests and crew embarking on every cruise anywhere in the world. Any guests or crew with a temperature detected at or above 100.4F / 38C will be denied boarding.



STRINGENT CLEANING AND DISINFECTION PROTOCOLS

have been implemented on board all voyages that are above and beyond our already rigorous standard protocols.



GENERAL HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES



SCREENING IS OUR FIRST LINE OF DEFENSE.

We have standard pre-boarding health questionnaires and all guests and crew members are screened for symptoms. Crew members are required to have various up-to-date vaccinations, and if they become ill, are isolated until cleared by shipboard medical staff.

WE HAVE ONBOARD MEDICAL CENTERS STAFFED WITH EXPERIENCED MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS WHO ARE AVAILABLE 24/7 TO PROVIDE MEDICAL CARE AND SERVICES.

Centers are well equipped with supplies and medications for a broad range of illnesses. All crewmembers are also trained in first aid and public health practices specific to their responsibilities onboard.



We work closely with World Health Organization & Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for best health and safety practices onboard our ships and have rigorous sanitization standards always in place across our ships. We work closely with CDCs Vessel Sanitization Program and are subject to at least two unannounced inspections each year in addition to regular formal internal health inspections.

PUBLIC HEALTH AUTHORITIES WORLDWIDE ALSO INSPECT CRUISE SHIPS AND ENFORCE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS.
